Goodrich Aerostructures is a division of Goodrich Corporation which is a global supplier of systems and services to aircraft and engine manufacturers, airlines and defense forces around the world. The aerostructures group, located in Chula Vista, produces aerostructures, such as engine-related components, including engine nacelles, thrust reversers, and mounting pylons for both military and commercial aircraft. Goodrich Aerostructures also consults on integrating and managing its designs with the aircraft's other systems. Other products include APUs, flight control surfaces, and other aircraft parts.
