The final planning meeting for this year's Engineering Week Banquet was held on Monday, February 12<sup>th</sup> at the Joan Kroc Institute of Peace and Justice. Preparations for the banquet appear to be coming together very well. Current reservations for the banquet stand at 238. The maximum capacity of the banquet room at IPJ is 248 so we are very near a sell-out. We have one corporate sponsor (\$1000), five company sponsors (\$500 each) and four societies co-sponsoring awards (\$200 each). The projected gross income (pledged and paid) for the banquet to date is \$9763.

AIAA still owes \$200 for our co-sponsoring the Goodrich Aerospace Best Project and \$150 for the four additional AIAA members attending the banquet above our original table of eight. I will need a check for \$350 made out to CSPE/NEW tonight. I will get that check to NEW treasurer, Ken Dicenza tomorrow.

All people attending the banquet will have to check in at the registration table upon arriving at the banquet. You will be given your table number, entrée ticket (chicken, fish or veg.) and a ticket for one beverage. You can buy additional beverage tickets for \$3.00 each during the event. Because we have 12 members attending and an AIAA table seating eight, four members will have to share a table with members of another society. Check in starts at 6:00PM with dinner at 7:00 PM.

The attached Membership Status spreadsheet (Attachment A) prepared from the San Diego Professional Summary report shows current Professional Membership of 401, a decrease of 4 from last month. There were 4 New Members, 2 Transfers-In, 4 Transfers-Out and 8 Drops.

There were 7 in the "Two Months Past Due" category. These are the members whose dues expired on 30 November and have not yet renewed. 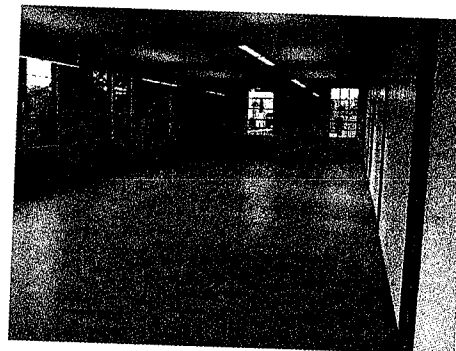
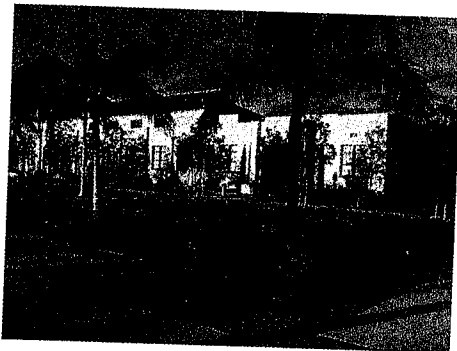
### *Grants and Application*
