During the banquet a number of awards were presented to recognize the efforts of the San Diego area engineers who made outstanding contributions to engineering practice, education, engineering technology, society and the San Diego community. The keynote speaker, Mr. Bert Marsh followed the award presentation. Marsh let the successful effort to raise the ship and recover the bodies for their relatives. Captain Marsh discussed the Ehime Maru incident and facts. He described the initial search for the vessel, its damage survey, the salvage methods considered and the seven phases of recovery. Bert Marsh is an excellent presenter and had an interesting topic that drew many questions from the capacity crowd.
